PRME CHAPTER AFRICA CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FROM THE AFRICAN DIASPORA for the first CHAPTER STEERING COMMITTEE (CSC)

CALL OPENS: Monday 4th April 2022 CALL CLOSES: Monday 9th May 2022

PRME Chapter Africa calls for nominations from the **African Diaspora** for Chapter Steering Committee (CSC) Members. Up to two members of the CSC will be appointed from the <u>African Diaspora</u>, <u>defined by the African Union</u> as "people of Africa origin living outside the continent, irrespective of their citizenship and nationality and who are willing to contribute to the development of the continent ...".

Nominations for CSC members from the African Diaspora are **welcome from all communicating PRME schools** around the world. It is a SELF NOMINATION process, but you are required to provide some supporting information. The nomination form provides all the required information you need to complete the nomination.

The approved PRME Chapter Africa Governance Statement is available on the PRME website <u>HERE</u>. Paragraph 8.4 of the Governance Statement sets out the procedures for the appointment of the first CSC.

NOTE: Call for nominations by PRME communicating schools in Africa

The call for nominations for the balance of CSC members will be separately sent to all communicating PRME schools or universities in Africa, by email, to the contact persons registered with the PRME Secretariat, as well as to the Deans of those schools. If you wish to submit a nomination from a communicating PRME school or university in Africa, please contact those responsible for PRME initiatives at your school, in order to proceed with the nominations process.
